 - ◆ **Earthquake**



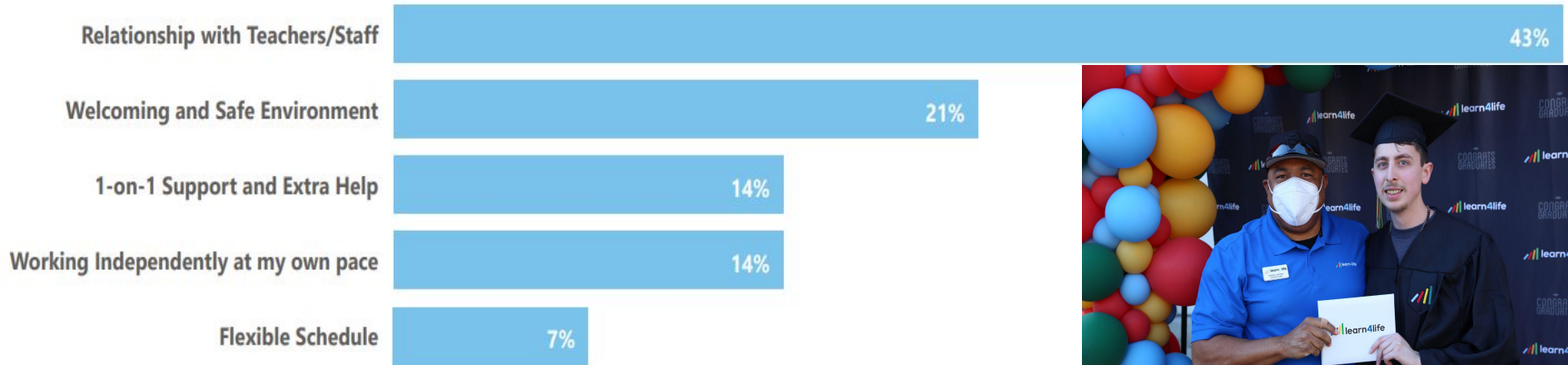
WASC Updates

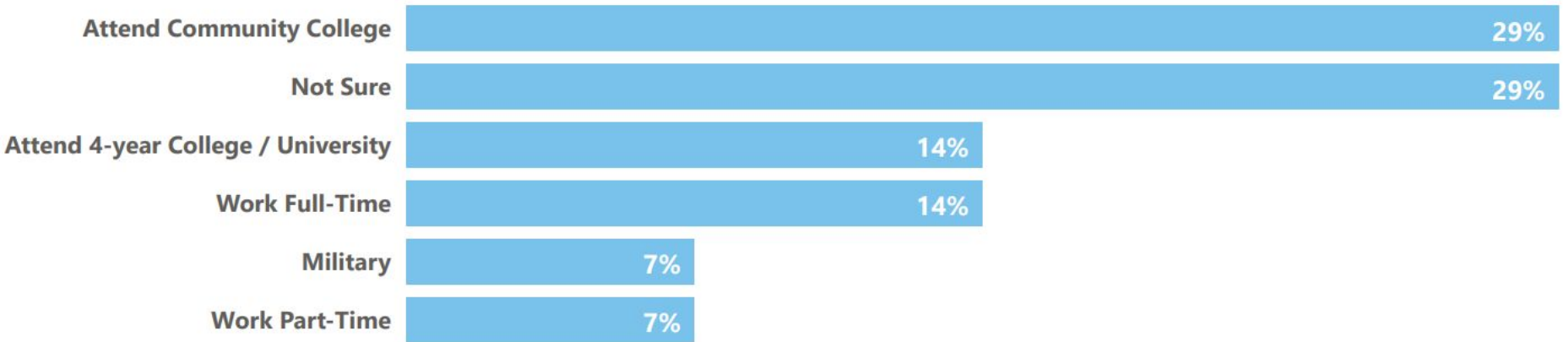
Alumni Survey Data

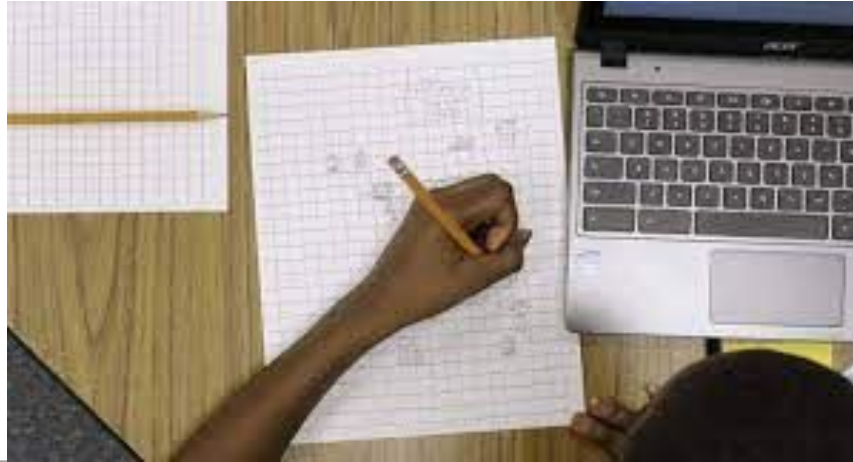
