Deadline to participate in the ceremony is **Fri. Dec. 17th!** 


#### Senior Advising Meetings

### • <u>Immunizations:</u>


All students must be compliant on all state required
 vaccinations to be onsite (Polio, DTAP, Tdap, MMR, Varicella, etc.)



### STUDENT DRESS CODE

#### Requirements:

- · Clothing may not depict, imply, or advertise alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or firearms.
- Clothing may not state, imply, or depict hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race-ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, or religious affiliation.
- Clothing may not depict or imply pornography, nudity, or sexual acts<sup>1</sup>.
- Clothing must cover areas from one armpit across to the other armpit, down to approximately 4 inches in length on the upper thighs. Tops must have shoulder straps.






