## Criteria To Reclassify


- 1. Student performance on the Reading of the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) in a school year. A score of 207 or higher on the NWEA is required.
- 2. Complete 5 English credits with a grade of C or better in a school year.
- 3. Overall Score of Level 4 on ELPAC.



# How do we support and prepare our EL students to reclassify?

- Keep students coming into school as much as possible.
- Work on and complete English credits.
- Students work one-on-one with tutors and paras.
- Students work with teachers in person or virtual meetings.
- Students take an online Reading Test to determine their level in English and that helps place them in the right English course.
   We offer FLRAC Test Prop SCL class
- We offer ELPAC Test Prep SGI class.

# Reclassification Percentage 3 Year Comparison



#### The ELPAC TEST PREP SGI COURSE

- A 5-module prep course for EL students
- Prepares students for the Summative ELPAC with reclassification as the ultimate goal
- Course will be scheduled for January
- Duration: Once or twice a week, lasting 1 2 hours per session
- It would cover Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking domains along with test-taking strategies.



#### **Module 1: Listening**

- Help students develop their abilities in listening in English.
- Practice active listening
- Signal words
- Taking notes as they listen



#### **Module 2: Reading**

- Help students develop their abilities to closely read a text, offer interpretation and analyze language.
- Close reading (taking notes on the margins, highlighting, reading with a purpose)
- Context clues
- Deconstructing questions
- Process of elimination



#### Module 3: Writing

- Help students develop their abilities in writing in English.
- Writing complete sentences
- Condensing and connecting ideas
- Writing paragraphs (5 sentences)
- Deconstructing writing prompts and fully addressing the task being asked
- Creating a writing plan
- Taking a position on an argument and providing appropriate supporting reasons



#### **Module 4: Speaking**

- Help students develop their abilities in speaking in English.
- Strategic pausing and gathering of thoughts before answering
- Practice reading and summarizing graphs, charts or images
- Taking notes while listening
- Using details from information presented
- Orally present summaries



#### Module 5: Practice Tests and Test-Taking Strategies

- Serves as a Performance Task.
- Will be used to review areas of weakness.
- Practice test-taking strategies
