# Legal Update

- ★ Since 2019, we've been battling court cases by Grossmont Unified and San Diego Unified school districts, trying to close our centers and take away education opportunity for hundreds of students.
- ★ **Well, we are so happy to announce that we won our case under appeal!**
- ★ All schools in San Diego will continue to operate legally and your student can continue their education without disruption.
- ★ We are dedicated to protecting your student's education and right to school choice. Schools like Learn4Life are essential for the community, helping students who need a flexible schedule and one-on-one personalized learning.
- ★ We are grateful that the judge agreed with our students' rights to choose their school.



# School Safety Updates

- ▶ On-Campus staff – 50% (Alternating Days)
- ▶ Students may come in for 30-Min appointments
- ▶ Work Stations are regularly sanitized
- ▶ Contact-Tracing -- Fingerprints
- ▶ Social Distancing Strictly Enforced

# Student Expectations

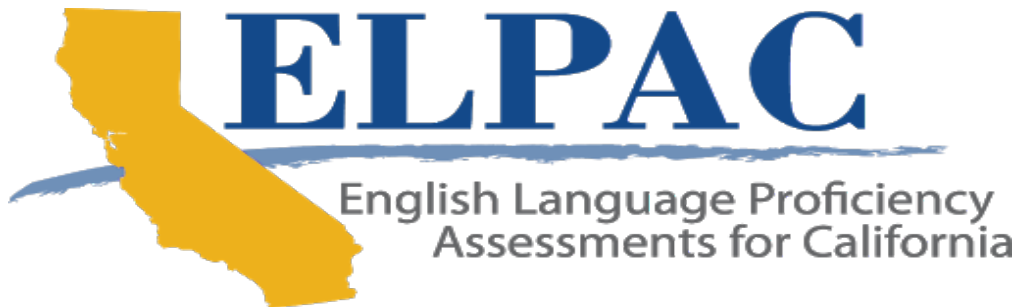
ELAC



- **ELPAC** is a state mandated test for all English language learners.
- **School Window: Ends March 19**
- State Window: Ends May 31
- Our goal is 100%, this means we will test every EL student

# ELAC

- **How and where ELPAC is performed?**
- **Test is mainly on site following CDC guidelines**
- **Only 5-6 students per 2-hour- session**
- **Practice Social distance**
- **Wear masks at all times**
- **Sanitize the room after each session**
- **Remote testing is reserved for special circumstances**





# ELAC

## Importance of ELPAC/Criteria for reclassification

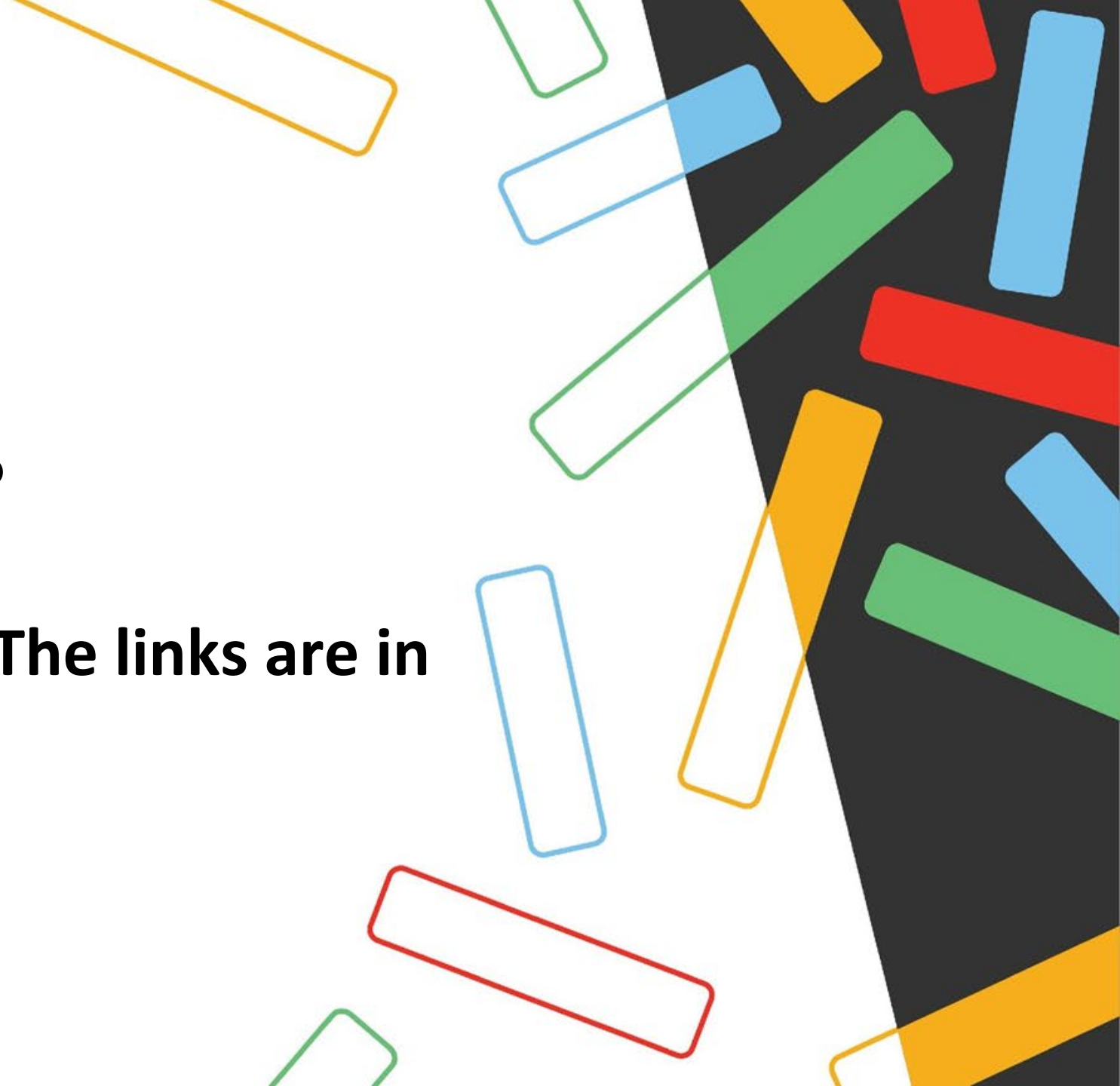
1. Student performance on the Reading of the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) in a school year. A score of **207 or higher** on the NWEA is required.
1. Complete **5 English credits** with a grade of C or better in a school year.
3. Overall Score of Level **4** on ELPAC.
