EL Reclassification

- Student performance on the Reading of the Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) in a school year. A score of 207 or higher on the NWEA is required.
- Complete 5 English credits with a grade of C or better in a school year.
- Overall Score of Level 4 on ELPAC.

How are ELL students supported?

- Keep students coming into school as much as possible.
- Work on and complete English credits.
- Students work one-on-one with tutors and paras.
- Students work with teachers in person or virtual meetings.
- Students take an online Reading Test to determine their level in English and that helps place them in the right English course.

• We offer ELPAC Test Prep SGI class.

ELPAC Test-Prep Course

- A 5-module prep course for EL students
- Prepares students for the Summative ELPAC with reclassification as the ultimate goal
- Course will be scheduled for January
- Duration: Once or twice a week, lasting 1 2 hours per session
- It would cover Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking domains along with test-taking strategies.
