 - Increase Academic Performance: EL growth 35%, Reading increased 58%, Math increased 45%, credit completion went up to 3.4 average
 - Students will gain skills for college and career readiness: offering more CTE, dual enrollment went down because of a glitch in enrollment process, but we are ramping up for next school year, state-wide assessments are about the same as last year, need to work on state testing growth
 - Increase Student Retention Rate: 93% attendance, 0 suspensions or expulsions
 - Increase Parent Engagement: 96 parents last year to 190 this year, 20% participated in the survey and 30% this year, 45% last year and 54% of students participated in the survey this year, 88% of staff participated
